4th Grade Parents,

This is the week! EOGs are here. Some things I have reminded students for EOGs that you may want to reiterate at some point in the next few days:

- For reading passages, always find the answer in the text, even when you think you *know* the answer. Take the time to find it in the text. Most questions are missed because students rush through answer choices.
- Eliminate at least TWO answer choices. There are usually two really off-the-wall wrong answer choices and eliminating them will give students a 50/50 chance of choosing the correct one.
- Take your time. Take a deep breath. This is a sprint, not a race.
- For math, work out each problem. Show your work. Use your paper. Also - remember that some word problems are multi-step word problems and the EOG-creators know that some students will only complete the first step and choose that answer choice.
- Do your best! We are proud of all your hard work!
