This week..

ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS - We will have *Geometry* vocab. again this week - see math section below.

We will continue to dissect reading passages. Each passage lasts about two days because we are really breaking them down. We are down to our last few chapters of *Treasure Island*. Our morphology lesson will be the suffixes -ful and -less.

MATH - I am overall very pleased with students' ability to identify rays, lines, segments, etc., We will be introducing 2D shapes and their properties this week. Students' vocabulary words this week will be some of the major 2D shapes we'll be talking about this week. Students will be given an image and should be able to identify the image (with word bank). SCIENCE - Students will be reading about the water cycle this week and learn about how water changes forms as it moves throughout the water cycle.
